LONG RANGE FULLBORE CHAMPIONSHIP
Match Bulletin**

- Match dates:** May 19, 20 & 21, 2023 (practice afternoon May 18)
- Rules:** NRA Intl Fullbore rules apply. For F-class, see section #22 NRA Intl Fullbore rules. Match will be V2 compliant for F-class competitors.
- Rifles allowed:** Any rifle chambered in unmodified calibers 308 or 223. F-class see Rule 3.4 (a) & (b).
- Sights:** Metallic sights only (other than F-Class); telescopic sights allowed under Rule 3.7 (b)
- Ammunition:** Bullet weight under 156 gr (308) or 92 gr (223), except F-class categories (no bullet or caliber restrictions within F-class rules).
- Targets:** 800/900/1000 yds – LR & LR-FC
All firing to be conducted on Shot Marker electronic targets.
- Classifications:** NRA classification not required to participate. All unclassified competitors will fire in Master class. Competitors with no Fullbore classification but have other NRA High Power classifications shall be given an Assigned Fullbore Classification equal to their highest High Power classification (Rule 19.6).
- Open to:** Anyone with safe rifle and ammunition shooting prone, F-TR or F-Open.
- Entries:** Limited to first 75 pre-registered competitors.
- Entry fee:** \$120 3-day aggregate (or daily fee \$45) + team (optional)
- Registration:** Please pre-register using attached form. Fees will be collected day of match.
- Awards:** Medals for top competitors in each classification by class and by aggregate. Minimum participation levels in each class required. Awards for fullbore compliant category competitors only.
- Location:** 6005 Alliance Road NW (OH-43), intersection of Alliance Rd (OH-43) & Maple Street Malvern OH 44644
- Squadding:** At 1000 yard line, gates open 7:00am. Firing commences at 8:30am.
- Firing:** Pair firing, two to a mound, at all times. Relay members will alternate shooting and scoring each other. Shooter has 45 seconds to fire after scoring prior shot is complete.
- Other:** No range or shooting carts allowed on the firing line (to facilitate pair firing and conform to Intl Fullbore requirements). Competitors encouraged (but not required) to conform to all other Intl Fullbore requirements (sling width, trigger weight, wind flags, etc.).

Course of fire: Friday (2 min blow off period all days):

800 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

900 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

1000 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

Saturday:

800 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

900 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

1000 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

Sunday:

800 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

900 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

1000 yards: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record (Rule 8.2.2) - pair fired

Practice/Team: If enough interest is shown and enough time is available, a two-man team match will be held immediately following Fri & Sat indiv matches. Teams will be 2-man with course of fire to be determined prior to the match.

The range will be open and available for squadded practice on Thursday afternoon (time TBD).

General info: There is no power or water service on the range. Portable sanitation units are provided at the 1000 yard firing line. Competitors are responsible for providing their own food and beverages during the match.

In the event of rain, the match will continue as scheduled. In the event of lightning in the area, the match will be delayed until safe. There is no rain date for the match, and no refunds of match fees once paid.

Lodging available in the Canton and Carrolton, Ohio, areas.

There is no signage on OH-183 for the range. The access road is located through the parking lot of Cambridge Mills (a collection of single-story whitewashed block buildings on the north side of OH-183). Look for the road sign at the intersection of Alliance Road & Maple Street. See the detailed map on the ARC website (www.AllianceRifleClub.org).

Parking is available behind the 1000 yard line. The 800 and 900 yard lines are not accessible by vehicle, and range carts are highly recommended to transport gear from the 1000 yard parking lot.
